BACK TO SCHOOL SUPPLIES



The Mission Social Action Committee will begin the annual summer collection of "Back to School " supplies for our Covenant to Care for Children Social Worker clients.

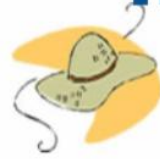
